WHAT IS THE RESIDENTS' CORNER AWARD?

2023 marks the first year of the **Residents' Corner Award**, a new annual award for a resident publication within the EACTS journals and Residents' Corner section. Applications for the award will be open until 31st May.

Shortlisted candidates will have an opportunity to showcase their publication via EACTS in the lead up to the Annual Meeting. The winner will be notified in September and invited to the Resident Session 'Science worth spreading' and awarded a certificate at the upcoming EACTS Annual Meeting.

WHAT IS THE RESIDENTS' CORNER?

The European Journal of Cardio-Thoracic Surgery (EJCTS) and Interdisciplinary CardioVascular and Thoracic Surgery (ICVTS) believe in the importance of scholarship in the progression of the next generation of cardiothoracic surgeons.

In order to support this development, the journals have launched the **Residents' Corner**, which highlights the excellent research performed by residents and papers relevant to residents.

EACTS resident members who have published a peer-reviewed article within the last 3 years as the 1st-, 2nd-, 3rd-, last- or corresponding author will be eligible to submit their paper for the award.

Essential Criteria Author must be an active cardiothoracic surgery resident.

EACTS Trainee Membership is a requirement to apply for this Award. If you
