## NEW AWARD FOR EACTS RESIDENTS

The EACTS Residents' Committee is pleased to announce the launch of a new award for EACTS Residents: **The Residents' Corner Award**

This award has been established to recognize the academic work of resident members of EACTS, with the aim of incentivizing residents to participate in academic research and scholarship and encourage article submissions to the **EJCTS and ICVTS Residents' Corner**.

## WHAT IS THE RESIDENTS' CORNER AWARD?

2023 marks the first year of the **Residents' Corner Award**, a new annual award for a resident publication within the EACTS journals and Residents' Corner section. Applications for the award will be open until 31<sup>st</sup> May.

Shortlisted candidates will have an opportunity to showcase their publication via EACTS in the lead up to the Annual Meeting. The winner will be notified in September and invited to the Resident Session 'Science worth spreading' and awarded a certificate at the upcoming EACTS Annual Meeting.

## WHAT IS THE RESIDENTS' CORNER?

The *European Journal of Cardio-Thoracic Surgery (EJCTS)* and *Interdisciplinary CardioVascular and Thoracic Surgery (ICVTS)* believe in the importance of scholarship in the progression of the next generation of cardiothoracic surgeons.

In order to support this development, the journals have launched the **Residents' Corner**, which highlights the excellent research performed by residents and papers relevant to residents.

# APPLICATION GUIDELINES

## ELIGIBILITY

EACTS resident members who have published a peer-reviewed article within the last 3 years as the 1<sup>st</sup>-, 2<sup>nd</sup>-, 3<sup>rd</sup>-, last- or corresponding author will be eligible to submit their paper for the award.

### Essential Criteria

Author must be an active cardiothoracic surgery resident.

### Publication Platforms

Published articles on the following EACTS platforms:

- *European Journal of Cardio-Thoracic Surgery (EJCTS)*

### Publication Type

Accepted publication types:

- Original research
- Reviews and Meta-analysis

### Authorship

Applicants must have published within the last 3 years as the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, last or corresponding author.

### Submission

Please submit a copy of your **Publication** and a **Project Summary** of the paper (approx. 500 words) to include:

- Project details
- Research methods
- Clinical implications of the work

## PRIZE

The winner will receive an Award Certificate and complimentary registration to the relevant year's EACTS Annual Meeting.

To submit your publication or nominate a resident's publication, please complete the [ONLINE FORM](#) and upload the following required documents:

- Project Summary
- The Publication itself (PDF)

The Residents' Committee will assess each application according to a transparent scoring system.
